

Getting Started

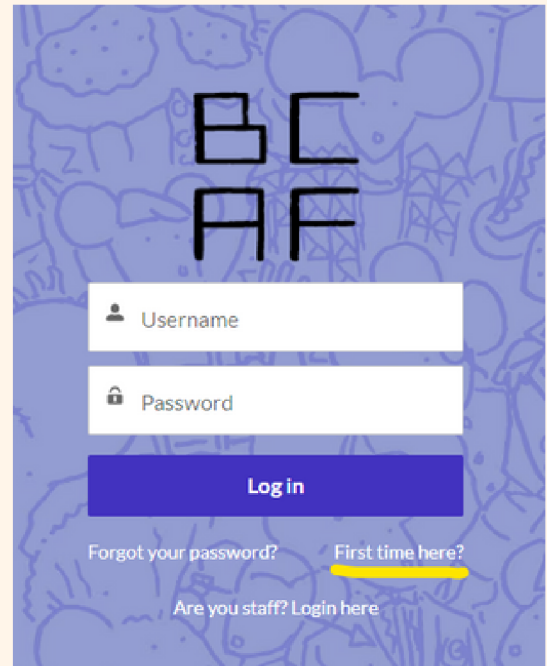
We have partnered with our parent organization the Boston Comic Arts Foundation to develop a Creator Portal to make applying for MICE year after year, easier. Follow the steps below to create your Creator Portal account and begin your application for MICE 2023.

Register

Go to <https://portal.bostoncomicarts.org>.

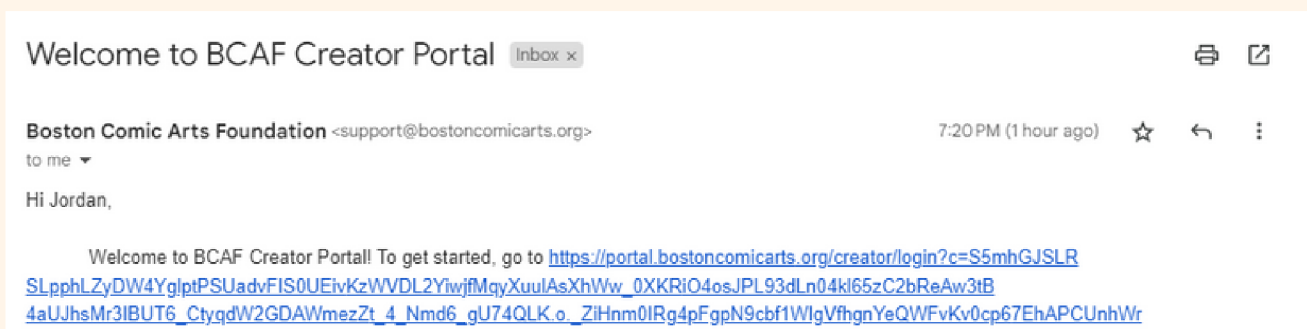
You need to sign up for an account before you can apply. Select "First time here?" on the bottom right to build your account.

Please note whatever email you use to register will be your username for your account.




Activate your account

You'll get an email prompting you to activate your account. Follow the link in the email to get started.



Create a password

Before you get started, you need to set up a password for your Creator Portal account so you can come back and access it any time!

- 1 number

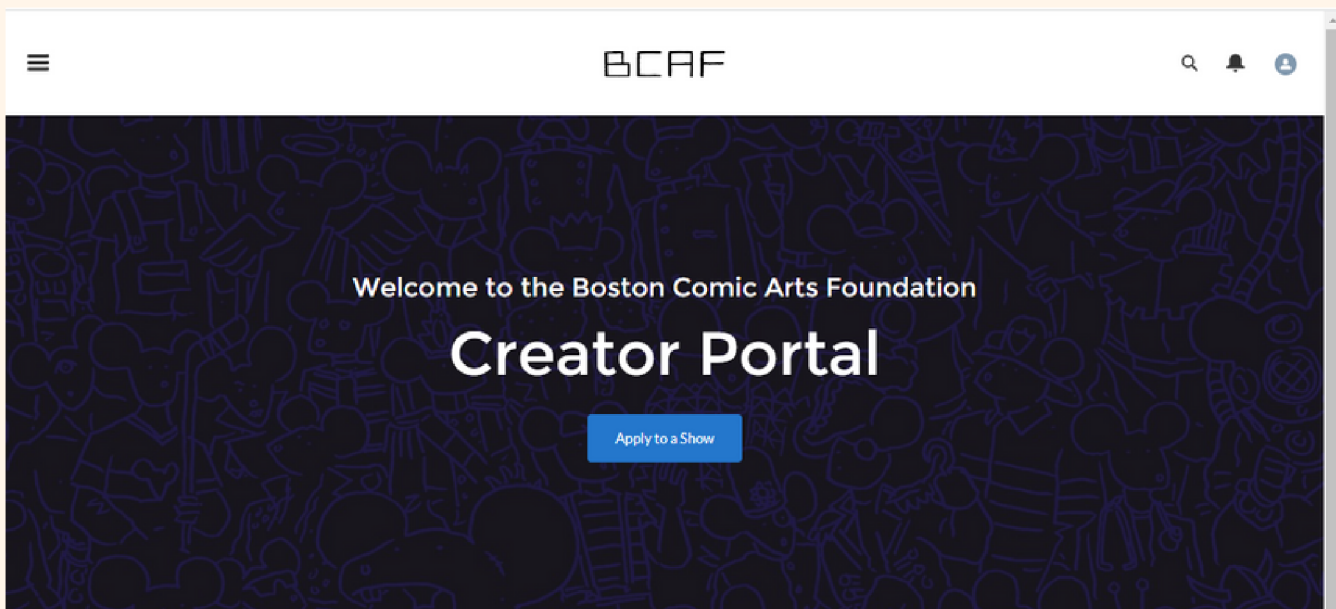

Apply to a show

After you create your password, you will be brought to the Creator Portal dashboard. To submit an application, select "Apply to a Show."

Start your application!

First, we'll start with some information that will be posted publicly should you be accepted as an exhibitor. Let us know what your exhibitor name should be. This is whatever should be displayed on the MICE website and on your badge. Please also provide a website, if applicable.

Now you're ready to fill out your MICE application, starting with your your portfolio. Select "Next" to go through all the application menus. The sections covered are Portfolio, Table Request, and some final questions.

Cool, now the good part: we need to review your comics! Full comics are better than excerpts and we also accept thumbnails or pencils of works in progress.

Upload a PDF portfolio of your comic work. You can submit up to 10 files with a max file size of 2GB. If you have trouble attaching, please send samples to mice@bostoncomicarts.org
